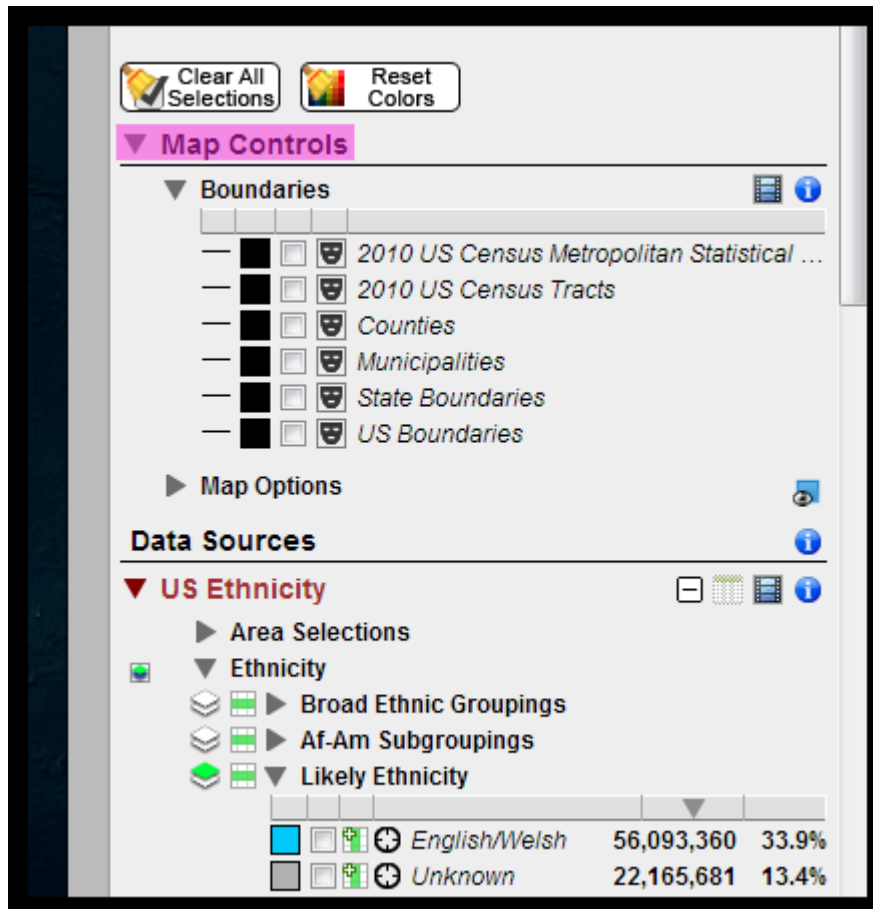


# United States Ethnicity – Boundaries

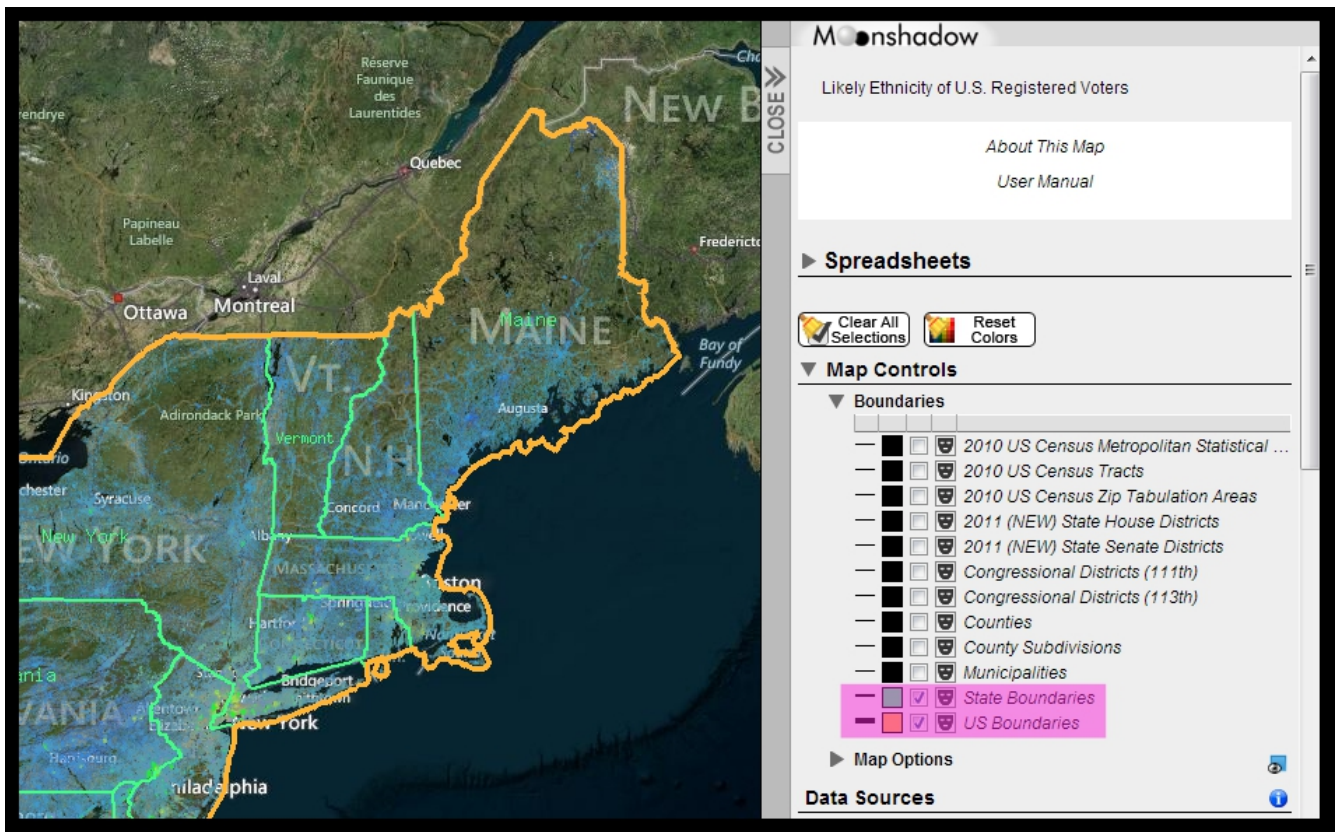
## Applying Boundary Layers

You can apply boundary layers to the map to easily visualize the extent of the selected boundary areas.

1. Find Boundaries under Map Controls in the Sidebar Menu.



2. To turn on a boundary, click on the check-box next to the desired boundary. You can turn on multiple layers at once and have different boundaries active simultaneously. If you want to be able to differentiate multiple boundaries you have turned on, or simply make the map look differently, you can make the boundaries different colors.



3. You can change the line thickness of a boundary by clicking on the line to the left of its name. This will allow you to cycle through 5 line thickness levels. To make the line thinner again, simply continue to click on it- it resets back to the thinnest setting after it has reached the thickest.
4. Finally, you can remove boundary layers from the map by unchecking the boundary check box.
