The so-called "dictatorship of the mother and son" fell in the 1977 elections (a defeat that Mr. Mehta calls the greatest modern political upset), but Mrs. Gandhi's successors as Prime Minister, Morarji Desai and Charan Singh, were in their turn forced out of office—in the main because of questions about the political influence of their families. Mr. Mehta shows in detail how Mrs. Gandhi survived charges of nepotism and corruption to sweep back into power in 1980; how Sanjay was at last elected to office, as a member of Parliament; and how mother and son reestablished their court autocracy in New Delhi, with Sanjay assuming the role of heir apparent. Then, in June, 1980, at the age of thirty-three, Sanjay was killed while executing a dangerous flip in a plane over the city. Mr. Mehta goes on to show how Mrs. Gandhi's older son, Rajiv, carried on the Gandhi "dynasty" in the Indian "democracy," and Mrs. Gandhi continued to face India's age-old problems—poverty, overpopulation, a rigid caste system, warring states—amid gathering unrest.
